



Music at St Bartholomew the Great October to December 2011

This quarter's music list takes us through the season that anticipates the coming of the Kingdom, with All Saints, All Souls and Remembrance, concluding with the Feast of Christ the Universal King. Then the new liturgical year begins on Advent Sunday, 27 November. This is the earliest that Advent can begin. It gives us four clear weeks, with Christmas Day being on a Sunday, and allows us to explore and value the traditional Advent themes of death, judgment, hell and heaven, and the liturgical themes of the coming kingdom, the witness of John the Baptist, and the obedience of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Then, after the season of ceaseless carolling, we reach the huge climax of Christmas itself.

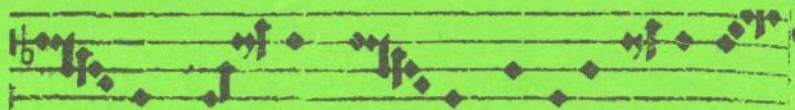

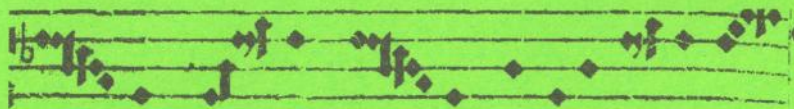
